The phone comes with Android 10 (Go Edition) out of the box, has a large 5.7-inch HD+ screen with waterdrop cutout and thin bezels, and a generous 3,000mAh battery. You also have an 8MP camera on the back, 1GB of RAM and 16GB of internal storage, a microSD slot that accommodates up to 400GB of storage, and the Qualcomm 215 platform delivers reliable performance. HMD says the device is ready for Android 11, with an update being released as soon as the Go edition of Android 11 becomes available. The design itself follows the minimal aesthetics of Nokia's industrial design, and you get an entry for 3.5mm headphones here. The best part about the Nokia 1.3 is that it is officially available in the USA, and works with T-Mobile, AT&T, and a wide variety of MVNOs. You take 8GB of storage out of the box, and while it's great that Alcatel allows you to expand it with a microSD card, we wish it went beyond the maximum of 32GB. While it may seem silly to say this to a phone that costs as little as the Alcatel 1, the real draw for this phone is its camera experience. You have a 5MP rear camera and a 2MP selfie camera, and although there's nothing special about the sensors themselves, alcatel packed a ton of features on the phone's camera app. There is a Photo Booth mode that captures four photos in three seconds in a configuration similar to a photo booth. In addition, there is an Instant Collage function that helps you easily create a collage of your photos and a one-handed mode that brings all camera controls up to the bottom section of the display. Alcatel 1 is available in a trio of colors (Black, Blue and Gold) and supports 4G LTE connectivity. Keep in mind that this is an international device, which means that it does not come with a warranty and may have some connection problems in rural areas or crowded buildings. Similar to most Android Go devices, the Galaxy J2 Core has only 8GB of onboard storage. However, you can use a microSD card to expand it up to an impressive 256GB. That's more than enough space for all your favorite movies, music, games and more, making this an excellent choice for anyone who likes to store all their files locally. Outside of excellent storage, the J2 Core also shines with its clean design, three available colors and 2,600 mAh battery. As long as you don't mind the lost warranty and weaker LTE coverage in rural parts of the country, the Galaxy J2 Core is a robust Android Go option. It is also available in two colors, including an elegant black and gorgeous blue. Powering the Blade L8 is a quad-core processor, 1GB of RAM and a 2,000 mAh battery. You get 16GB of storage just out of the box, and if you need to, you can expand it up to 128GB with a microSD card. There is also an 8MP rear camera along with a 5MP front camera for all your selfies. The Nokia 1 Plus offers a large 5.45-inch screen, an 8MP rear camera and a 3D nano-standard polycarbonate shell that looks excellent. It is also offered with 1GB of RAM phone, 8GB of internal storage that can be expanded up to 128GB, and a 2,500 mAh battery. You're getting a lot of bang-for-your-buck, so if you're able to buy the Nokia 1 Plus, it's definitely a phone worth checking out. The 3,500 mAh battery should allow excellent resistance, have a microSD card slot for expandable storage is always appreciated, and the fingerprint sensor makes it easy to log in to your sensitive applications. For the price ulefone is asking for, the Note 7 is a resounding success.
